Screening Blood Tests

- IUI multicycle packages must be paid in full before the first cycle is started and completed within 12 months.

Treatments for oral ovulation induction (up to 6 months course) and others such as metformin (for polycystic ovaries) will have the prescription issued and posted out, to be taken to any local pharmacy and attracts an initial £50 prescription fee. Repeat prescriptions are not charged for. Often the GP will continue a medication once initiated by a specialist Consultant.

For IVF medication, a personalized costed plan will be worked out and sent to the couple before treatment begins. This will depend on factors such as treatment type, choice of protocol, age of female, weight and gonadotrophin stimulation type and dose. Luteal support (taken after embryo transfer) also depends on the type of treatment and so varies. A homecare pharmacy delivery service is used for these medications.
